PSLMC Resolution No. 03, s. 2007

WHEREAS, PSLMC Resolution No. 1, s. 2001 provides that a maximum of four (4) duly elected employees' representatives, one each from the National Government Agencies (NGA), Local Government Units (LGU), Government-Owned or Controlled Corporations (GOCC) including Government Financing Institutions (GFI), and State Universities and Colleges (SUC), will be recognized to participate during PSLMC deliberations;

WHEREAS, in the plenary session of the National Public Sector Labor-Management Congress on September 22, 2005, the motion to increase employees representation to the PSLMC by electing eight (8) principal employees' representatives, two (2) from each sector, was unanimously adopted, thereby, eight (8) principal employees' representatives were elected to participate in PSLMC deliberations;

WHEREAS, in the PSLMC first quarter meeting on March 29, 2007, the duly elected employees' representatives proposed to the Council the increase in employees representation to the PSLMC considering the size, geographical situation and communication limitations of the sectors being represented;

WHEREAS, in said meeting, the Council did not interpose any objection to the proposal of the employees' representatives;

WHEREFORE, the Council hereby **RESOLVES**, as it hereby **RESOLVED** to approve the increase in employee representation to the PSLMC by recognizing eight (8) duly elected principal employees' representatives to actively participate during PSLMC deliberations. However, the observer capacity of such representatives remains and they are not conferred voting rights per PSLMC Resolution No. 1, s. 2001.


