SUBJECT : 2020 International Day of Persons with Disabilities

The **National Council on Disability Affairs (NCDA)** shall lead the observance of **International Day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD)** on **December 3, 2020** in accordance with UN General Assembly Resolution 47/3 issued on October 14, 1992.

With the theme "*Building Back Better: toward a disability-inclusive, accessible and sustainable post COVID-19 World*", it aims to promote an understanding of disability issues and mobilize support for the dignity, rights and well-being of persons with disabilities. It also seeks to increase awareness of gains to be derived from the integration of persons with disabilities in every aspect of political, social, economic and cultural life.

To promote public awareness in the week-long observance of this event, all government agencies are encouraged to extend full support by initiating or conducting fitting activities and to display the official 2020 IDPD streamer (design template can be downloaded at <http://www.ncda.gov.ph>).
