Regional Conferences/Homecoming of

Government Retirees

One of the activities lined up for the celebration of the Philippine Civil Service Centennial is the Regional Conferences/Homecoming of Government Retirees. The Civil Service Commission, through its regional and field offices, shall take the lead in the preparations for the regional assembly of government retirees.

The regional conference/homecoming shall have the following objectives:

- to encourage all government retirees to organize themselves;
- to build up retirees awareness and interest on the various opportunities for volunteer work and livelihood programs available to them; and
- to make retirees feel the importance of their contributions to the bureaucracy.

The CSC Central Office, jointly with the CSC National Capital Region and the CSC Retirees' Association, shall take charge of the conduct of the regional conference/homecoming day for government retirees in the National Capital Region. It shall be held on September 22, 2000 at the Civil Service Commission, Diliman, Quezon City. The other CSC Regional Offices shall hold the same activity in the regions, the date and time to be announced later.

All government agencies are enjoined to encourage their respective retirees to organize themselves (per office or region) on or before August 15, 2000, in case they have not yet formed an organization or association.

Furthermore, to develop a database on government retirees, all government agencies and instrumentalities are requested to prepare a directory of their retirees (still living) which includes their current residence addresses, birthdates and telephone numbers. Said directory should be submitted on or before August 31, 2000 to the CSRO which has jurisdiction over their regional office to give ample time for consolidation/reproduction. In the case of the National Capital Region, the directory should be submitted to Director Consolacion C. Santos, Project Manager of the Committee on Regional Conferences/Homecoming of Government Retirees, CSC Central Office, Diliman, Quezon City

To ensure the success of this activity, it is suggested that each region create a committee composed of officials/representatives from CSROs, regional government agencies, and different associations of government retirees. The committee shall be in charge of coordination and monitoring work, and preparations for the conduct of the regional conference/homecoming day. As an integral part of the program on homecoming day, resource persons shall be invited to talk on topics of general interest to retirees such as volunteerism work and livelihood programs.

Your cooperation is hereby enjoined.
