MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO

ALL HEADS OF CONSTITUTIONAL DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS, OFFICES AND AGENCIES OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT; LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS; STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES; AND **GOVERNMENT OWNED OR CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS** WITH ORIGINAL CHARTERS

SUBJECT :

Conduct of Basic Competency on Local Treasury **Examinations and Grant of Local Treasurer Eligibility**

Under CSC Resolution No. 1701330 dated September 20, 2017, the Commission shall conduct the Basic Competency on Local Treasury Examination (BCLTE) and shall grant the Local Treasurer Eligibility (LTE) to successful examinees.

Individuals who are interested to join the local treasury service shall also be allowed to take the BCLTE provided they meet the admission and qualification requirements of the examination. Said requirements shall be provided in the guidelines to be issued by the CSC.

The BCLTE shall be conducted on November 26, 2017. Two (2) BCLTE shall be administered in 2018, and once every year after 2018.

An examination fee of PhP700.00 shall be collected from each qualified applicant.

Passers of the December 6, 2015 BCLTE shall likewise be granted the LTE. The grant of eligibility to these passers shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication of abovementioned CSC Resolution in a newspaper of general circulation.

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The LTE shall be an equivalent eligibility to the second level or first grade eligibilities such as the Career Service Professional and RA 1080. It shall only be appropriate for appointment to positions of Local Treasurers, Assistant Local Treasurers, and positions in the Financial Services which do not require the practice of profession and are not covered by Bar/Board or Special Laws, subject to meeting all the qualification requirements the positions. The list of positions under the Financial Services is attached as Annex A.

The CSC Resolution No. 1701330 shall take effect on October 6, 2017.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Article IX-B, Section 2 (2) of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that appointments in the civil service shall be made only according to merit and fitness to be determined, as far as practicable, and, except to positions which are policy-determining, primarily confidential or highly technical, by competitive examinations:

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission (CSC), as the central human resource agency of the government, is mandated by the Constitution to establish a career service for all levels and ranks, prescribe, develop, and conduct civil service examinations as determinants of merit and fitness, and assist other agencies of the government to develop and conduct tests;

WHEREAS, Section 12 (7), Chapter 3, Title I (A), Book V of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise known as the Administrative Code of 1987 provides that the CSC shall have the power to control, supervise, and coordinate civil service examinations, and may call upon any entity or official in government to assist in the preparation and conduct of the examinations. Under such authority, the CSC, upon the request of the Department of Finance (DOF), conducted the Basic Competency for Local Treasury Examination (BCLTE) on December 6, 2015;

WHEREAS, Sections 470 (c) and 471 (b), Article II, Title V of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991 provide, among others, that no person shall be appointed treasurer and assistant treasurer unless one is a citizen of the Philippines, a resident of the local government unit concerned, of good moral character, a holder of a college degree preferably in commerce, public administration or law from a recognized college or university, and a first grade civil service eligible or its equivalent. Also, appointment to Local Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer positions shall be made by the Secretary of the DOF;

WHEREAS, the DOF is instituting a three-level competency examination and certification policy under its Standardized Examination and Assessment for Local Treasury Service (SEAL) Program which aims to improve the competencies of local treasurers and assistant treasurers, and instill a culture of excellence in local treasury operations service and promote good fiscal governance in the Local Government Units (LGUs):

WHEREAS, the SEAL Program of the DOF further seeks to improve its recruitment and selection process so that only highly competent local treasurers or assistant treasurers are suited in the fiscal environment of the LGU they will serve. The Program is a solid and encouraging attempt to further professionalize the ranks of treasurers to improve local governance;

WHEREAS, DOF Department Order No. 053-2016 dated October 20, 2016 provides for the proposed qualifications of the examinees for the SEAL 1, BCLTE and SEAL 2, Intermediate Competency for Local Treasury Examination (ICLTE). Further, the Department Order states that Seal 1 (BCLTE) shall be open to any interested applicant who intends to join the local treasury services;

WHEREAS, the DOF has requested the CSC to develop and conduct again the BCLTE, and to consider the SEAL 1 (BCLTE) as an eligibility examination and grant second level civil service eligibility to successful examinees of the BCLTE;

WHEREAS, the Commission finds the request of the DOF meritorious;

WHEREFORE, the Commission hereby RESOLVES, as follows:

 Develop and conduct an eligibility examination for Local Treasurers which shall be known as the Basic Competency on Local Treasury Examination (BCLTE);

Individuals who are interested to join the local treasury service shall also be allowed to take the BCLTE provided they meet the admission and qualification requirements of the examination. Such requirements shall be provided in a separate guideline to be issued by the CSC.

- 2. Conduct the BCLTE on November 26, 2017;
- 3. Conduct two (2) BCLTE in 2018 and once every year thereafter;
- 4. Collect from each qualified applicant an examination fee of PhP700.00 which may be changed upon appropriate review and determination by the Commission;
- 5. Grant the Local Treasurer Eligibility (LTE) to the passers of the December 6, 2015 BCLTE and to all passers of succeeding BCLTEs. The eligibility that will be granted to passers of the 2015 BCLTE shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication of this CSC Resolution. That is, the effectivity of the LTE to be conferred the qualifiers will coincide with the effectivity date of this CSC Resolution;



6. The LTE shall be an equivalent eligibility to the second level or first grade eligibilities such as the Career Service Professional and RA 1080. It shall only be appropriate for appointment to Local Treasurer and Assistant Local Treasurer positions, and to positions under the Financial Services which do not require the practice of profession and are not covered by Bar/Board or Special Laws, subject to meeting all the qualification requirements of the positions. The list of positions under the Financial Services is attached as Annex A.

This Resolution shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
