SUBJECT

Public Sector Volunteerism for Honest, Orderly and Peaceful Elections (HOPE) 2004 Thru the Spirit of 100 Hours: Alay sa Bayan.

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission, pursuant to Republic Act No. 6713 or the Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards of Government Officials and Employees, has been promoting volunteerism in the government service through its Spirit of 100 Hours: Alay sa Bayan Program;

WHEREAS, the forthcoming May 2004 elections provide a significant opportunity for channeling the spirit of volunteerism;

WHEREAS, there is no prohibition against government officials and employees to volunteer their services to the NGOs recognized and accredited by the COMELEC like
