The International Labour Organization (ILO) Country Office in the Philippines, will be conducting a 2-Day "Training Workshop on Collective Bargaining in the Public Sector" this coming 27-28 September 2014 at the Cocoon Boutique Hotel, Quezon City.

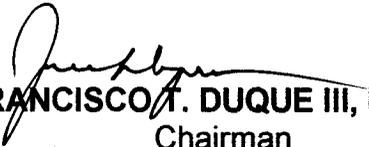
This training aims to capacitate a core group of workers' and employers' representatives in establishing and sustaining social dialogue mechanisms, focusing on collective bargaining or negotiations. Specifically, participants shall have increased awareness and understanding on the principles, techniques and methods in establishing and maintaining social dialogue mechanisms, focusing on collective bargaining. They are also expected to come up with proposals on how workers and management can promote social dialogue and collective bargaining in the public sector.

Target participants for this training are forty-five (45) senior representatives from workers' organizations and management bodies in the civil service.

All concerned government employees are encouraged to participate in this event. It is discretionary on the part of the agency heads to allow their employees to attend the subject occasion on official/business time, as provided for under CSC Memorandum Circular No. 43, s. 1993.

The ILO-CO will provide board and lodging for participants from outside Manila and shall reimburse their transportation expenses upon presentation of official receipt during the event.
