(PLAI) in partnership with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) through the National Committee on Libraries and Information Services (NCLIS) and the National Library of the Philippines (NLP), will hold its annual National Congress on November 21-24, 2017 at the SMX Convention Center, SM City Bacolod, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental.

With the theme "Libraries Take Action: Providing Access and Opportunity for All", it aims to equip Filipino Librarians and information professionals with different strategies needed to transform libraries and information centers as agents of development by implementing formal, informal and lifelong learning programs.
