SUBJECT: 11th World Autism Awareness Day

On April 2, 2018, the country will celebrate the 11th World Autism Awareness Day (WAAD) pursuant to United Nations General Assembly resolution 62/139 which declared WAAD as one of the four official health-specific United Nations Days that aims to bring the world's attention to autism, a global health crisis. - Simultaneous lighting-up in blue of any edifices, landmarks and other related structures on April 2 at exactly 6:00pm; and
