RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 3, Article IX-B of the 1987 Constitution provides that "the Civil Service Commission as the central personnel agency of the Government, shall establish a career service and adopt measures to promote morale, efficiency, integrity $x \times x$. It shall strengthen the merit and rewards system, integrate all human resources development programs for all levels and ranks, $x \times x$ ";

WHEREAS, Section 12(1), Chapter 3, Title I (A), Book V of Executive Order No. 292 (Administrative Code of 1987), provides that the Commission shall administer and enforce the constitutional and statutory provisions in the merit system for all levels and ranks in the Civil Service;


WHEREAS, under the 1997 Revised Qualification Standards Manual (as implemented by CSC Memorandum Circular No. 1, s. 1997), the prescribed eligibility for the Guidance Counselor position is Career Service (Professional) or appropriate second level eligibility;

WHEREAS, with the passage of Republic Act No. 9258 (Guidance and Counseling Act of 2004) on March 2, 2004, the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) created the Professional Regulatory Board of Guidance and Counseling, the powers and functions of which include, among others, the supervision and regulation of the practice of Guidance and Counseling;

WHEREAS, Sec. 3, Article I of the said Act defines a Guidance Counselor as "a natural person who has been registered and issued a valid Certificate of Registration and a valid Professional Identification Card by the Professional Regulatory Board of Guidance and Counseling and the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC)":

WHEREAS, Section 14, Article III of the said Act provides that "a person who possesses the pertinent qualifications required for admission in the examination for registration as guidance counselor pursuant to the provisions of this Act may be registered without examination: Provided, That the applicant files with the Board x x x an application for registration and issuance of a Certificate of Registration and Professional Identification Card x x x";









WHEREAS, in order to conform to the provisions of RA 9258, there is a need to amend the eligibility requirement of the following Guidance Counselor positions prescribed in the 1997 Revised Qualification Standards Manual:

However, they shall not be eligible for promotion to higher Guidance Counselor positions unless they meet the required RA 1080 (Guidance Counselor) eligibility.

This Resolution shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication.
