Extension of Deadline for Submission of Nominations on the 2007 Search for Outstanding Public Officials and Employees

In its continuing advocacy for the recognition of public service exemplars in the government, the Civil Service Commission announces the extension of the deadline for the submission of nominations to the 2007 Search for Outstanding Public Officials and Employees from March 30, 2007 to April 30, 2007.

This is to afford high flyers in government to join the Search and be recognized in any of the three awards categories, the *Lingkod Bayan* Award and the *Pagasa* Award (for outstanding work performance), and the *Dangal ng Bayan* Award for exemplary ethical behavior.

Nominations shall be accepted by the Commission until April 30, 2007 through its 'central, regional, provincial and field offices nationwide.

The Commission continues to enjoin all government agencies to strengthen efforts in recognizing men and women who have made a difference in rendering public service. The Commission also encourages individuals or organizations with extensive knowledge of the outstanding performance or exemplary behavior of an official, employee or group/team to nominate such official, employee or group/team by submitting said nomination to the nominee's office, provincial or regional PRAISE (Program on Awards and Incentive for Service Excellence) Committee. Qualified individuals or group of individuals should be nominated pursuant to the 2007 Revised Guidelines on the Conduct of the 2007 Honor Awards Program (HAP) extensively disseminated earlier to all branches of the government.
