HOLD-OVER CAPACITIES OF INCUMBENT SECTORAL REPRESENTATIVES IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR LABOR-MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (PSLMC) MEETINGS

PSLMC Resolution No. 04 s. 2009

WHEREAS, the Council in its PSLMC Resolution No. 3, series 2007 dated July 24, 2007, approved the increase of sectoral representations to attend in the Council's meetings from four (4) to eight (8) employees' representatives from the four (4) sectors of government employment;

WHEREAS, upon approval of the abovestated PSLMC Resolution, the Council outrightly amended PSLMC Resolution No. 1, series 2001 dated April 23, 2001, wherein such sectoral representations were limited only to four (4) employees' representations;

WHEREAS, in the course of the eight (8) sectoral representations in the Council meetings, six (6) of them lost their rights to represent by virtue of one's retirement from the government service; termination of term of office as President of one's union; losing his elective position as President of one's union during the union's election, among others;

WHEREAS, the terms of office of the remaining two (2) sectoral representatives to the PSLMC from the Government-Owned and/or Controlled Corporations (GOCCs) namely Dr. Carolina M. Basilio and Mr. Ceferino C. Lopez who were elected during the National Congress for Government Workers on September 22, 2005, their rights of representations in the Council had already expired on September 22, 2008;

WHEREAS, while these employees' representatives sit only in their observer capacities during the meetings of the Council, they have actively participated in its deliberations which proved useful in the promulgation of opinions and decisions of the PSLMC;

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes their significant roles as sectoral representatives in the Council, the body offers no objection as to the extension of their terms as sectoral representatives in the PSLMC to ensure continuous representations of government employees in the PSLMC.

WHEREFORE, the Council hereby RESOLVES, as it hereby RESOLVED to allow the remaining two (2) sectoral representatives elected during the National Congress for Government Workers on September 22, 2005 to continue with their participation in their observers' capacities in the meetings of the Council until such time that the next employees' representatives are elected through a process to be determined by the workers in the forthcoming conduct of the National Workers' Congress.
