Re: Amendments to Section 1, Rule XIX of the
Amended Implementing Rules and Regulations of

PSLMC Resolution No. 5, s. 2010

WHEREAS, Section 1, Rule XIX (Jurisdiction) of the Amended Rules and Regulations of Executive Order No. 180 provides that **CSC-PRO shall have original and exclusive jurisdiction** over the following:

- (a) petition for accreditation;
- (b) petition challenging accreditation;
- (c) disputes involving eligibility for employees' organization membership outside of certification election proceedings; and,
- (d) disputes involving registration or interpretation of CNAs.

WHEREAS, it has been observed by the CSC-PRO that employees' associations/unions have been referring disputes on amendments of Constitution and By-Laws (CBL), conduct of elections, and interpretation of union's Constitution and By-Laws for resolution;

WHEREAS, the said Section 1, Rule XIX (Jurisdiction) it does not categorically include the above stated disputes under the jurisdiction of the CSC-PRO, which should have been resolved with dispatch if jurisdiction is vested with it;

WHEREFORE, the Council **RESOLVES** as it hereby **RESOLVED** to amend **Section 1, Rule XIX (Jurisdiction)** of the Amended Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Executive Order No. 180 to read, as follows:

"Section 1. CSC-PRO Original and exclusive jurisdiction.- The CSC-PRO shall have original and exclusive jurisdiction over the following:

- (a) *petition for accreditation;*
- (b) *petition challenging accreditation;*
- (c) *disputes involving eligibility for employees' organization membership outside of certification election proceedings;*
- (d) *disputes involving registration or interpretation of CNAs;*

- Public Sector Labor Management Council**
- (e) disputes involving interpretation or amendments of Constitution and By-Laws (CBL); and
 - (f) disputes involving conduct of election of officers.

RESOLVED further, that the CSC-PRO will immediately submit to the Council its decisions on Items (e) and (f) of the amendments of Section 1, Rule XIX of the Amended Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Executive Order No. 180 and the same are appealable to the Council within fifteen (15) calendar days from its receipt by the parties.

This Resolution shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
