The Philippine Librarians Association, Inc. (PLAI), in partnership with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) through the National Committee on Libraries and Information Services (NCLIS) will hold its 2014 National Congress on November 26-28, 2014 at the Century Park Hotel, Malate, Manila.

With the theme "***Philippine Libraries: Future Possibilities***", the Congress aims to gather ideas that will bring positive changes in the way Philippine Libraries are being built and managed, following international standards in the provision and delivery of services.
