SUBJECT : Training Seminar on Positive Education in the Philippines: Educating for Academic Success and for Well-being Program

Selected four hundred (400) public and private school teachers in Marikina and Metro Manila will be invited to participate in the program. All concerned government employees are encouraged to participate in this event. It is discretionary on the part of the agency heads to allow their employees to attend the subject occasion on official/business time, as provided for under CSC Memorandum Circular No. 43, s. 1993.
