SUBJECT : One Million Lapis

The Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC), the focal government interagency body mandated to formulate policies and plans, monitor the implementation and enforcement of laws to protect and promote children's rights by virtue of Presidential Decree 603, otherwise known as the Child and Youth Welfare Code, will embark on its advocacy project entitled "One Million Lapis".

The One Million Lapis campaign aims to collect One Million pencils to be given to underprivileged students in elementary schools of 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> class Municipalities and set a Guinness Book of World Record for the longest line of Lapis.

In line with this advocacy, all government agencies are enjoined to participate in this event by providing a drop box for the One Million Lapis Project, where interested individuals can place their pencil donations. The Lapis drop-boxes will be collected every two months. Kindly coordinate with CWC on the collection of the drop-boxes.
