**SUBJECT : ASEAN Leaders Programme**

The Common Purpose Asia Pacific, with the support of General Electric (GE) and in partnership with the Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN) Foundation, invites government agencies and public servants to participate in the **ASEAN Leaders Programme**.

The ASEAN Leaders Programme is an annual, two-part leadership development programme that seeks to bring together seventy (70) senior leaders from ten ASEAN countries - from all sectors and walks of life - onto a common platform where they can work together to address a challenge relevant to the region. The challenge for the ASEAN Leaders Programme 2016 is "**What makes a city smart?**"

Government agencies may nominate one (1) participant based on the following criteria:

- operates at a senior, strategic level in their organization and/or society;
- holds significant power of influence in their current role;
- are close to the pinnacle of their career, with ambitions to achieve even more;
- are excited about the opportunity that the ASEAN Leaders Programme provides
