Frequently Asked Questions

Is there a payment for applying to STEP UP?

Application to the program is free. The Philippine Aptitude Test for Teachers (PATT) and the partner TEI's entrance exam shall both be administered for free.

Recruiters are not allowed to accept any fee from the applicants as well.

Can I work while studying under the scholarship?

Yes. Since CTP only requires a minimum of 18 education units, classes are only held during weekends, at night, or for several hours on weekdays.

Is there an age limit?

Applicants must not be older that 45 years old.

How long is the scholarship coverage?

The scholarship of CTP scholars shall be covered for a maximum of one year, which is the maximum length of time to finish the certification program. Afterwards, LET review and examination assistance shall be provided.

Do you have a scholarship for teachers who want to take up a master's degree?

No, we don't. The scholarship is focused on pre-service training or training of individuals who are yet to be placed in the public school.

What happens if I was not able to finish the program?

This will be arranged on a case to case basis but the **scholarship benefits must be paid** as soon as possible.

What happens if I wasn't hired by DepEd to teach in public schools?

You are given three (3) attempts to apply to DepEd in the duration of five (5) years. You should inform us accordingly and provide proof of the status of your application. After such time has elapsed and you still have not been accepted, you are free to pursue other endeavors beyond the required return service of STEP UP. However, we still highly encourage you to pursue teaching even in the private schools.

*STEP UP Philippines strongly encourages Persons With Disabilities (PWD) and Indigenous Peoples to apply for the scholarship grant.
