## BACKGROUND

### Inventory of Government Human Resources (IGHR)

The Civil Service Commission (CSC) is mandated, among others, to keep and maintain the bureaucracy-wide human resource (HR) records in the Philippine Civil Service (PCS). The CSC, being the central HR institution, continuously creates records as it documents its day-to-day operation and all events pertinent to HR management, actions, programs, and policies, which form part of the HR records. These records constitute a strategic input to the HR administration/management, policy formulation, budget allocation, decision-making, and to its performance in the attainment of its goals and mission.

Among the important data that may be culled from the HR records are the statistical data on HR profile of the PCS. The statistical data is important not only the research/studies but also in the formulation of government policies/programs, budget allocation, and decision-making, it is therefore incumbent on the part of the Commission to ensure accuracy and timeliness of the statistical data/inventory of government human resources.

The first recorded statistics on the number of officials and employees in the PCS was in the year 1961, followed by a statistical data that was gathered through a survey project known as the “CSC – National Manpower and Youth Council Manpower Survey Project 1971 – 1973” and both statistics were done manually. In December 1993, with the advent of emerging ICT technology, the first ICT-driven Inventory of Government Personnel (IGP) was conducted to get a more accurate headcount of government officials and employees.

The CSC conducted the last IGP for calendar year 2010 with a total number of 1,409,660 government workforce. On January 7, 2014, the responsibility for the conduct of IGP was transferred to the Integrated Records Management Office (IRMO) with the promulgation of CSC Resolution No. 140041 on the “Transfer of Selected OSM Functions to Other Offices of the Civil Service Commission”. Pursuant to the said Resolution, the CSC IRMO developed the Inventory of Government Human Resources System (IGHRS) to answer the need to institutionalize a regular conduct of the Inventory of Government Human Resources (IGHR).

The IRMO embarked on the **IGHR Version 1.0** project which aims to centralize the collection of data from all the government agencies nationwide. It has three modules: (1) Module I for the CSCROs/FOs online account registration; (2) Module II for the agency HRMO online/offline account registration and compliance monitoring; and (3) Module III for the agency encoding of inventory data. Data encoding of the different agencies can be viewed and monitored in the system by the IRMO Information Technology Division (ITD). On the other hand, the CSC Field Offices

can view and monitor the compliance of agencies under their jurisdiction and the CSC Regional Offices can also view and monitor their respective Field Offices' compliance.

The IGHR-registered agency HRMOs started encoding their HR inventories from December 2015 to March 2016. The first Inventory of Government Human Resources (IGHR) report was generated on the 1st Semester of 2016 which recorded a grand total of 1,874,978. It is composed of 1,236,361 career service personnel, 132,499 non-career service personnel, and 506,118 personnel who were hired under Job-Order (JO) and Contract of Service (COS) status.

The annual IGHR has been conducted since 2016 and the data were posted in the CSC website. With the implementation of the **IGHRS Version 2.0** which included the module for the plantilla of personnel in CY 2019, report generated dated May 31, 2019 was based on the agencies' actual plantilla of career positions.

Then, for CY 2020 data for the Non-career positions and Job-Order/Contract of Service were also integrated in the **IGHRS Version 2.0**. These will depict a more realistic data/information based on the actual head count on the ground for the career, non-career and JO/COS.

Below shows the comparative IGHR reports, by classification of positions and by year, starting from CY2016 until the recent report:
