**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**

**SUBJECT :** Approved Qualification Standards for Airfield Power Technician positions

Pursuant to CSC Resolution No. 96-8318 dated December 23, 1996, the approved qualification standards for the positions of Airfield Power Technician are as follows:

**1. AIRFIELD POWER TECHNICIAN I - SG 04**

**Education :** Completion of two years relevant studies in college or Completion of high school with relevant vocational/trade course

**Experience :** None required

**Training :** None required

**Eligibility :** RA 1080 (Certified Plant Mechanic) or (Master Electrician)  
Career Service (Subprofessional)

**2. AIRFIELD POWER TECHNICIAN II - SG 06**

Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in college or Completion of high school with relevant vocational/trade course

Experience : None required

Training : None required

Eligibility : RA 1080 (Certified Plant Mechanic) or (Master Electrician)  
Career Service (Subprofessional)

**3. AIRFIELD POWER TECHNICIAN III - SG 09**

Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in college or Completion of high school with relevant vocational/trade course

Experience : 1 year relevant experience

Training : 4 hours of relevant training

Eligibility : RA 1080 (Certified Plant Mechanic) or (Master Electrician)  
Career Service (Subprofessional)

**4. AIRFIELD POWER TECHNICIAN IV - SG 11**

Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in college or Completion of high school with relevant vocational/trade course

Experience : 2 years relevant experience

Training : 8 hours of relevant training

Eligibility : RA 1080 (Certified Plant Mechanic) or (Master Electrician)  
Career Service (Subprofessional)

5. **AIRFIELD POWER TECHNICIAN V - SG 13**

- Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in college  
or Completion of high school with relevant  
vocational/trade course
- Experience : 3 years relevant experience
- Training : 16 hours of relevant training
- Eligibility : RA 1080 (Certified Plant Mechanic) or  
(Master Electrician)  
Career Service (Subprofessional)
